Position: Educator, Option C – Vacancies include High School, CTE (Career & Technical Education and PK-8)

Job Description: Under general supervision of the School Principal at the Illinois School for the Deaf, teaches appropriate level education courses to deaf, hard of hearing, and deaf/blind students. Applies standard and special teaching methods and techniques in instructing students who are deaf, hard of hearing, deafblind, or some students who have secondary disabling conditions. Adapts and revises standard practices or specialized teaching techniques to meet the needs of individual students. Prepares unit plans and lesson plans based on the curriculum and prepare other materials considering the individuals needs to students. Utilizes sign language to communicate with students on a daily basis.

Minimum Qualifications: Requires possession of a current and valid ISBE-issued Professional Educator License (PEL) with endorsement appropriate to the content area, grade-level, and instructional area. Requires the ability to pass the sign proficiency exam at the Advanced level to instruct students who are deaf, hard of hearing, or deafblind. Requires the ability to prepare written documentation related to student performance and education.

Special Skills: Some vacancies may prefer Advanced training in the use of Cued Speech or an endorsement as a teaching speech-language pathologist.

Salary: \$3,135 - \$5,973 monthly

To Apply: In order to be considered eligible for state employment at ISD, you must submit a State of Illinois employment application (CMS-100) to the ISD Personnel Office.
