SPORTS CAMP

The Illinois School for the Deaf (ISD) is offering a sports camp for children who are deaf or hard of hearing. ISD is located on a 55 acre campus in Jacksonville, Illinois and has excellent facilities with two regulation-size basketball courts, a swimming pool and two weight-lifting rooms. Campers will live in dormitories with two to a room on the ISD campus; eat meals in the cafeteria and to attend camp in one of ISD's two gymnasiums. The camp will open on Sunday, June 18th after 1:00 p.m. and close after awards on Friday, June 23rd.



CAMP GOAL

The camp's goal is to provide the campers the opportunity to improve communication and socialization skills and practice good sportsmanship while improving their skills in various games and activities.



CAMP FEES

- \$60.00 per camper to include:
 - Camp T-shirt
 - Recreational activities

Deadline for applying for the camp is

May 15, 2017

If camper is registered before

April 28, 2017 camp fee will be \$50.00 for registering early

After April 28th, camp fee will be \$60.00



CAMP ACTIVITIES

A new sport or game will be introduced each day. Campers will spend the mornings and afternoons receiving specific skill instruction and participating in the activity of the day. Various recreational activities will be offered during the evenings. An awards program will be held on Friday, June 23rd, beginning at 1:00 p.m.



CAMP ACCOMMODATIONS

- Campers will share a bedroom in an ISD dormitory. Bedding and towels are provided.
- Campers will eat breakfast, lunch and dinner in the ISD dietary.
- Campers are supervised 24 hours a day by ISD Staff.



CAMP INSTRUCTORS

- During the day campers will be instructed by ISD Educators highly qualified in the field of physical education or have experience coaching.
